**IN RE: SB1290** by Van de Putte (Relating to authorization for school districts to provide mentors for teachers assigned to a new subject or grade level.), **As Introduced**

The bill would specify that school districts may assign a mentor to teachers with less than two years of experience in the subject or grade level to which the teacher is assigned.
