**IN RE: SB1327** by Nelson (Relating to the disposition of surplus data processing equipment of a university system or an institution or agency of higher education.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

Under provisions of the bill, a university system or institution of higher education, as defined under Section 2151.002 of the Transportation Code, could donate data processing equipment that is surplus property to a public or private hospital located in a rural county.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
