IN RE: SB1334 by Hegar (relating to continuation of the intercollegiate athletics fee for students at Prairie View A&M University.), Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Education Code so that the Intercolligiate Athetics fee at Prairie View A&M University would not expire on September 1, 2013, as in current law, if bonds that are payable from the fee are issued before the end of the 2012-2013 academic year.
