IN RE: SB1478 by Carona (Relating to the authority of hospital districts to lease undeveloped real property.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code to authorize a hospital district, with approval of the county commissioners court, to lease undeveloped real property for not more than 50 years to provide for the development and construction of facilities designed to generate revenue for the financial benefit of the district.

Local Government Impact

It is assumed that a county commissioners court would approve allowing a hospital district to enter into a lease only if sufficient resources were available and if the commissioners and the district anticipate sufficient revenue would be generated as a result of development on the property.
