IN RE: SB1530 by Whitmire (Relating to including playgrounds in the designation of certain places as drug-free zones for purposes of the criminal penalties that apply to certain drug-related offenses.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code by including playgrounds in the designation of certain places as Drug-Free Zones. It is assumed that the bill would not significantly affect the operations of state or local government.
