**IN RE: SB1676** by Hinojosa (Relating to fees charged by certain counties near international borders for issuing certain utility certificates.), **As Introduced**

**No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Local Government Code to authorize the commissioners court of certain counties to impose a fee for a certificate issued under Section 232.029 for a subdivision that is located in the county and not within the limits of a municipality. The fee may be no greater than \$30 or the amount of the fee imposed by the municipality for a subdivision that is located entirely in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

**Local Government Impact**

The section of Local Government Code that would be changed applies to counties within 50 miles of the Texas-Mexico border and to Nueces County.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
