**IN RE: SB1699** by Fraser (Relating to consistency among certain secretary of state filings.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the filing fee for transmitting utility filings from \$15 for one or two pages and \$30 for three pages or more to \$60. Since the volume of transmitting utility filings is so low it is assumed that there would be no significant fiscal impact. The bill would be effective September 1, 2009.

**Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
