**IN RE: SB1804** by Zaffirini (Relating to medical assistance reimbursement for the provision of a wheeled mobility system to a recipient of medical assistance.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would authorize the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) to provide medical assistance reimbursement for a wheeled mobility system, under certain conditions, and would require the executive commissioner of HHSC to adopt related rules. HHSC assumes that the cost to implement the bill would not be significant and could be absorbed within existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
