IN RE: SB2006 by Hegar (Relating to the matters to be taken into consideration by a groundwater conservation district in determining whether to grant or deny a permit or permit amendment.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would allow a groundwater conservation district operating under an adopted limit on available or managed available groundwater to consider when issuing a permit or permit amendment whether the water supply needs, as determined in the most recent regional water plans, can be met.
