IN RE: SB2273 by Seliger (Relating to certain reporting duties of the attorney general and the Department of Aging and Disability Service.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Health and Safety Code and removes certain reporting requirements related to unlicensed assisted living facilities and convalescent and nursing homes. It is assumed that the fiscal impact would not be significant.
