A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a county to regulate the installation
3 and use of lighting in certain areas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 240.032(b-1), Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b-1) On the request of a United States military
8 installation, base, or camp commanding officer, the commissioners
9 court of a county[~~, any part of which is located immediately~~
10 ~~adjacent to the installation, base, or camp,~~] may adopt orders
11 regulating the installation and use of outdoor lighting within five
12 miles of the installation, base, or camp in any unincorporated
13 territory of the county.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 240.032(b-1), Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (b-1) This subsection applies only to a county with a
8 population of more than one million that has at least five
9 United States military bases and to any county adjacent to that
10 county that is within five miles of a United States Army
11 installation, base, or camp. On the request of a United States
12 military installation, base, or camp commanding officer, the
13 commissioners court of a county subject to this subsection~~[, any~~
14 ~~part of which is located immediately adjacent to the~~
15 ~~installation, base, or camp,~~] may adopt orders regulating the
16 installation and use of outdoor lighting within five miles of
17 the installation, base, or camp in any unincorporated territory
18 of the county.

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it
20 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
21 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
22 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary
23 for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
