5 SECTION 1. Section 31.039(f), Election Code, is amended to

7 (f) A person employed on a full-time basis by the
8 administrator's office is subject to Section 31.035 in the same
9 manner as the administrator. [~~This subsection applies only to
10 counties with a population of one million or more that have an
11 election administrator.~~]

(f) Except as provided by Subsection (g), a [A] person
9 employed on a full-time basis by the administrator's office is
10 subject to Section 31.035 in the same manner as the
11 administrator. [~~This subsection applies only to counties with a
12 population of one million or more that have an election
13 administrator.~~]

(g) Section 31.035(b) does not apply to a person employed
15 on a full-time basis by the administrator's office in a county
16 with a population of one million or less that has an election
17 administrator.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
