H.B. No. 3041

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to a comprehensive schedule of public school reporting
3 requirements.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 7.037 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 7.037. REPORTING SCHEDULE. The agency shall develop
8 and maintain a comprehensive schedule that addresses each reporting
9 requirement generally applicable to a school district, including
10 requirements imposed by an entity other than the agency, and that
11 specifies the date by which a school district must comply with each
12 requirement. The agency shall determine the appropriate format of
13 the schedule and the manner in which the schedule is made readily
14 accessible to school districts.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 7, Education Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 7.037 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 7.037. REPORTING SCHEDULE. (a) To the extent
8 possible, the Texas Education Agency shall develop and maintain a
9 comprehensive schedule that addresses each reporting requirement
10 generally applicable to a school district, including requirements
11 imposed by a state agency or entity other than the Texas Education
12 Agency, and that specifies the date by which a school district must
13 comply with each requirement.

14 (b) A state agency that requires a school district to
15 periodically report information to that agency shall provide the
16 Texas Education Agency with information regarding the reporting
17 requirement as necessary to enable the Texas Education Agency to
18 develop and maintain the schedule required by Subsection (a).

19 (c) The Texas Education Agency shall determine the
20 appropriate format of the schedule required by Subsection (a) and
21 the manner in which the schedule is made readily accessible to
22 school districts.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
