#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to written authorization for the release of certain health
- 3 care information.

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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 241.151(2), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (2) "Health care information" means information,
- 8 including payment information, recorded in any form or medium that
- 9 identifies a patient and relates to the history, diagnosis,
- 10 treatment, or prognosis of a patient.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 241.154, Health and Safety Code, is
- 12 amended by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection
- 13 (f) to read as follows:
- 14 (a) On receipt of a written authorization from a patient or
- 15 legally authorized representative to examine or copy all or part of
- 16 the patient's recorded health care information, except payment
- 17 <u>information</u>, or for disclosures under Section 241.153 not requiring
- 18 written authorization, a hospital or its agent, as promptly as
- 19 required under the circumstances but not later than the 15th day
- 20 after the date the request and payment authorized under Subsection
- 21 (b) are received, shall:
- (1) make the information available for examination
- 23 during regular business hours and provide a copy to the requestor,
- 24 if requested; or

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- 1 (2) inform the authorized requestor if the information
- 2 does not exist or cannot be found.
- 3 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the hospital or
- 4 its agent may charge a reasonable fee for providing the health care
- 5 information except payment information and is not required to
- 6 permit the examination, copying, or release of the information
- 7 requested until the fee is paid unless there is a medical emergency.
- 8 The fee may not exceed the sum of:
- 9 (1) a basic retrieval or processing fee, which must
- 10 include the fee for providing the first 10 pages of the copies and
- 11 which may not exceed \$30; and
- 12 (A) a charge for each page of:
- (i) \$1 for the 11th through the 60th page of
- 14 the provided copies;
- 15 (ii) 50 cents for the 61st through the 400th
- 16 page of the provided copies; and
- 17 (iii) 25 cents for any remaining pages of
- 18 the provided copies; and
- 19 (B) the actual cost of mailing, shipping, or
- 20 otherwise delivering the provided copies; or
- 21 (2) if the requested records are stored on any
- 22 microform or other electronic medium, a retrieval or processing
- 23 fee, which must include the fee for providing the first 10 pages of
- 24 the copies and which may not exceed \$45; and
- 25 (A) \$1 per page thereafter; and
- 26 (B) the actual cost of mailing, shipping, or
- 27 otherwise delivering the provided copies.

- 1 (f) A request from a patient or legally authorized
- 2 representative for payment information is subject to Section
- 3 311.002.
- 4 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to the disclosure or exchange of health care information under
- 6 Subchapter G, Chapter 241, Health and Safety Code, on or after the
- 7 effective date of this Act. The disclosure or exchange of health
- 8 care information before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 9 by the law as it existed immediately before that date, and that law
- 10 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

Amend H.B. No. 4029 (senate committee printing) as follows:

- (1) In SECTION 2 of the bill, in amended Section 241.154(b)(1)(B), Health and Safety Code (page 1, line 50), strike "or" and substitute "[er]".
- (2) In SECTION 2 of the bill, in amended Section 241.154(b)(2), Health and Safety Code (page 1, lines 51-52), strike "any microform or other electronic medium" and substitute "[any] microform [or other electronic medium]".
- (3) In SECTION 2 of the bill, in amended Section 241.154(b)(2), Health and Safety Code (page 1, line 57), strike "copies." and substitute the following: copies; or
- (3) if the requested records are provided on a digital or other electronic medium and the requesting party requests delivery in a digital or electronic medium, including electronic mail:
