H.B. No. 4311

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the naming of certain Texas Department of Transportation property in Val Verde County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subchapter P to read as follows:

SUBCHAPTER P. DEPARTMENT REGIONAL AND AREA OFFICES

Sec. 201.1000. VAL VERDE COUNTY AREA OFFICE. The office of the area engineer located in Val Verde County is designated as the Honorable Hilary B. Doran Transportation Building.

SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 225.071 to read as follows:

Sec. 225.071. DESIGNATION OF HIGHWAY LOOP IN VAL VERDE COUNTY. (a) In recognition of the cooperation between the department and the County of Val Verde, the name of Loop \_\_\_\_\_ located in Val Verde County shall be designated by the Val Verde County Commissioners Court.

(b) Upon the naming of Loop \_\_\_\_\_ by the Val Verde County Commissioners Court, the department shall design and construct markers to be placed along Loop \_\_\_\_\_ indicating the highway number, the name of the loop, and any other appropriate information.

(c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the loop and at intermediate sites along the loop that the department determines are appropriate.

1           SECTION 3. Section 1 of this Act takes effect immediately if  
2 this Act receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to  
3 each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas  
4 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for  
5 immediate effect, Section 1 of this Act takes effect September 1,  
6 2009. Section 2 of this Act takes effect September 1, 2010.

3 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Transportation Code, is amended by  
4 adding Subchapter Y to read as follows:

5 SUBCHAPTER Y. DEPARTMENT BUILDING NAMES

6 Sec. 201.2001. HONORABLE HILARY B. DORAN TRANSPORTATION  
7 BUILDING. The building in which, on June 1, 2009, is located the  
8 office of the area engineer for Val Verde County is designated as  
9 the Honorable Hilary B. Doran Transportation Building.

10 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
11 is amended by adding Section 225.072 to read as follows:

12 Sec. 225.072. LOOP 79 IN VAL VERDE COUNTY. (a) In  
13 recognition of the cooperation between the department and Val Verde  
14 County, the designation of Loop 79 in Val Verde County shall be made  
15 by the Commissioners Court of Val Verde County.

16 (b) The department shall design and construct markers to be  
17 placed along Loop 79 in Val Verde County indicating the highway  
18 number, the designation of the loop, and any other appropriate  
19 information.

20 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the  
21 loop and at intermediate sites along the loop that the department  
22 determines are appropriate.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
27 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
