A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the requirement for participation by certain principals
3 in the school leadership pilot program for principals.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.203(d), Education Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (d) A principal who was employed as a principal at a campus
8 that was [~~of a campus~~] rated academically unacceptable during the
9 preceding school year [~~, as well as any person employed to replace~~
10 ~~that principal,~~] shall participate in the program and complete the
11 program requirements not later than a date determined by the
12 commissioner.

13 SECTION 2. Section 11.203(d), Education Code, as amended by
14 this Act, applies only to a principal employed at a school that is
15 rated academically unacceptable during the 2008-2009 school year.

16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.203(d), Education Code, is amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (d) A principal who was employed as a principal at a campus
8 that was [of a campus] rated academically unacceptable during the
9 preceding school year [as well as any person employed to replace
10 that principal,] shall participate in the program and complete the
11 program requirements not later than a date determined by the
12 commissioner.

13 SECTION 2. Section 11.203(d), Education Code, as amended by
14 this Act, applies only to a principal employed at a school that is
15 rated academically unacceptable during the 2008-2009 school year.

16 SECTION 3. It is the intent of the legislature that the
17 passage of H.B. No. 3, Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular
18 Session, 2009, with any amendments to Section 11.203(d), Education
19 Code, and the amendments made by this Act shall be harmonized, if
20 possible, as provided by Section 311.025(b), Government Code, so
21 that effect may be given to each. If amendments made to Section
22 11.203(d), Education Code, by H.B. No. 3, Acts of the 81st
23 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, and the amendments to Section
24 11.203(d), Education Code, made by this Act are irreconcilable, it

1 is the intent of the legislature that H.B. No. 3, Acts of the 81st
2 Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, prevail, regardless of the
3 relative dates of enactment of this Act and H.B. No. 3, Acts of the
4 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, but only to the extent
5 that any differences are irreconcilable.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
10 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

The bill would eliminate required participation in the School Leadership Pilot Program for Principals for individuals hired to replace principals whose campuses earn an academically unacceptable rating.
