HOUSE VERSION

SECTION 1. Section 142.0013, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

- (d) A fire fighter or police officer is entitled to a paid day off from working on September 11 of each year if:

 (1) the fire fighter or police officer.
- (1) the fire fighter or police officer:
- (A) agrees or is required to work on a holiday during the same fiscal year and chooses to take that holiday on September 11; or
- (B) chooses to use a vacation day, a day in lieu of a vacation day or holiday, or accumulated compensatory leave to take a paid day off on September 11; and
- (2) the fire fighter's or police officer's supervisor does not require the fire fighter or police officer to work that day to maintain minimum staffing necessary for public safety.

SENATE VERSION

SECTION 1. Section 142.0013 (c), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(c) A fire fighter [and a police officer] shall be granted the same number of vacation days and holidays, or days in lieu of vacation days or holidays, granted to other municipal employees, at least one of which shall be designated as September 11th.

No equivalent provision.

SECTION __. Section 142.0013, Local Government Code, is amended by adding new subsection (d) to read as follows:

(d) A police officer shall be granted the same number of vacation days and holidays, or days in lieu of vacation days or holidays, granted to other municipal employees.
