SECTION 1. Section 105.02, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 105.02. HOURS OF SALE: WHOLESALERS

AND LOCAL DISTRIBUTORS TO RETAILERS. (a) <u>A holder of a wholesaler's permit</u> [Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, a wholesaler or a local distributor's permittee] may sell, offer for sale, or deliver liquor to a retailer <u>anytime</u> [between 5 a. m. and 9 p. m. on any day] except Sunday and Christmas Day. (b) A local distributor's permittee may [not] sell, offer

(b) A local distributor's permittee may [not] sell, offer for sale, or deliver [any] liquor to a retailer between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m. on any day except:

(1) Sunday;

(2) Christmas Day; or

(3) a day on which a package store permittee is prohibited from selling liquor.

SECTION 2. Section 105.051, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 105.051. SALE OF BEER BY DISTRIBUTOR'S LICENSEE. <u>The</u> [In addition to the hours specified for the sale of beer in Section 105.05(b) of this code, the] holder of a general, local, or branch distributor's license may sell, offer for sale, or deliver beer <u>24 hours a day</u> <u>Monday through Saturday and between midnight and 1</u> <u>a.m. and between noon and midnight on</u> [beginning at 5 <u>a. m. on any day except</u>] Sunday.
