# House Bill 4114

## Senate Amendments

#### Section-by-Section Analysis

#### HOUSE VERSION

SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 443.01525 to read as follows:

Sec. 443.01525. TEJANO MEMORIAL MONUMENT. The Committee on House Administration and the Senate Committee on Administration shall direct the State Preservation Board to place the Tejano memorial monument established by House Concurrent Resolution 38 of the 77th Legislative Session on the south lawn of the Capitol grounds to pay tribute to the contributions of Tejanos to the State of Texas. The committees shall establish rules and policies necessary to place the monument on the south lawn of the Capitol.

### No equivalent provision.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2009.

#### SENATE VERSION

SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 443.01525 to read as follows:

Sec. 443.01525. TEJANO MEMORIAL MONUMENT. The State Preservation Board shall establish a Tejano memorial monument on the historic south grounds of the Capitol that pays tribute to the contributions of Tejanos to the State of Texas.

SECTION 2. Section 443.0152, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows: (a-1) Except as provided by Sections 443.01525 and 448.034, after September 1, 2009, no additional monuments may be placed on the historic grounds of the Capitol.

SECTION 3. Same as House version.
