2	relating to the duty of a law enforcement agency to request

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
6	amended by adding Article 2.253 to read as follows:
7	Art. 2.253. INFORMATION REQUEST REGARDING ARRESTED
8	PERSON'S IMMIGRATION STATUS. Not later than 48 hours after a person
9	is arrested and before the person is released on bond, the law
10	enforcement agency that has custody of the person shall:
11	(1) request information regarding the person's
12	immigration status from:
13	(A) a peace officer or other law enforcement
14	officer of this state who is authorized under federal law to verify
15	a person's immigration status; or
16	(B) a federal law enforcement officer, in
17	accordance with 8 U.S.C. Section 1373(c); and
18	(2) notify United States Immigration and Customs
19	Enforcement that the person is in the custody of the law enforcement
20	agency if information received following a request under
21	Subdivision (1) reveals that the person:
22	(A) is not a citizen or national of the United
23	States; and
24	(B) is unlawfully present in the United States

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 8 legislative session.
