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         SECTION 1. (a) The following provisions of the Education

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         SECTION 2. Sections 12.133(b), (b-1), (c), and (d-1),
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   Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
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          (b) Each school year, using state funds received by the
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   charter holder for that purpose under Subsection (d), a charter
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   holder that participated in the program under Chapter 1579,
   Insurance Code, for the 2005-2006 school year shall provide
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   employees of the charter holder, other than administrators,
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compensation in the form of annual salaries, incentives, or other

- 1 compensation determined appropriate by the charter holder that
- 2 results in an average compensation increase for classroom teachers,
- 3 full-time librarians, full-time counselors, and full-time school
- 4 nurses who are employed by the charter holder [and who would be
- 5 entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402 if employed by a
- 6 school district, ] in an amount at least equal to \$2,500.
- 7 (b-1) Using state funds received by the charter holder for
- 8 that purpose under Subsection (d-1), a charter holder that
- 9 participated in the program under Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, for
- 10 the 2005-2006 school year shall provide employees of the charter
- 11 holder, other than administrators, compensation in the form of
- 12 annual salaries, incentives, or other compensation determined
- 13 appropriate by the charter holder that results in average
- 14 compensation increases as follows:
- 15 (1) for full-time employees other than <u>full-time</u>
- 16 classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time counselors,
- 17 and full-time nurses [employees who would be entitled to a minimum
- 18 salary under Section 21.402 if employed by a school district], an
- 19 average increase at least equal to \$500; and
- 20 (2) for part-time employees, an average increase at
- 21 least equal to \$250.
- (c) Each school year, using state funds received by the
- 23 charter holder for that purpose under Subsection (e), a charter
- 24 holder that did not participate in the program under Chapter 1579,
- 25 Insurance Code, for the 2005-2006 school year shall provide
- 26 employees of the charter holder, other than administrators,
- 27 compensation in the form of annual salaries, incentives, or other

- 1 compensation determined appropriate by the charter holder that
- 2 results in an average compensation increase for classroom teachers,
- 3 full-time librarians, full-time counselors, and full-time school
- 4 nurses who are employed by the charter holder [and who would be
- 5 entitled to a minimum salary under Section 21.402 if employed by a
- 6 school district, ] in an amount at least equal to \$2,000.
- 7 (d-1) In addition to any amounts to which a charter holder
- 8 is entitled under this chapter, a charter holder that participated
- 9 in the program under Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, for the
- 10 2005-2006 school year is entitled to state aid in an amount, as
- 11 determined by the commissioner, equal to the sum of:
- 12 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of
- 13 full-time employees other than <u>full-time classroom teachers</u>,
- 14 <u>full-time librarians</u>, full-time counselors, and full-time nurses
- 15 [employees who would be entitled to a minimum salary under Section
- 16 21.402 if employed by a school district]; and
- 17 (2) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 18 part-time employees.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 19.007(f), Education Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (f) In addition to other amounts received by the district
- 22 under this section, the district is entitled to state aid in an
- 23 amount equal to the product of \$2,000 multiplied by the number of
- 24 classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time counselors
- 25 certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school
- 26 nurses who are employed by the district [and who would be entitled
- 27 to a minimum salary under Section 21.402 if employed by a school

- 1 district operating under Chapter 11].
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 19.009(d-1), Education Code, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 (d-1) Each school year, the district shall pay an amount at
- 5 least equal to \$2,000 to each classroom teacher, full-time
- 6 librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B,
- 7 Chapter 21, and full-time school nurse who is employed by the
- 8 district [and who would be entitled to a minimum salary under
- 9 Section 21.402 if employed by a school district operating under
- 10 Chapter 11]. A payment under this section is in addition to wages
- 11 the district would otherwise pay the employee during the school
- 12 year.
- SECTION 5. Section 21.0031(b), Education Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (b) After an employee receives notice that the employee's
- 16 contract is void under Subsection (a), [+

- 8 document that indicates the total years of service provided to the
- 9 district by a classroom teacher, librarian, counselor, or nurse.
- 10 (c) If a school district fails to provide an individual's
- 11 service record as required by Subsection (b), the agency shall, to
- 12 the extent that information is available to the agency, provide the
- 13 employing school district with  $\underline{\text{the}}$  information [sufficient to
- 14 enable the district to determine proper placement of the individual
- 15 on the district's salary schedule].
- 16 (d) The commissioner shall adopt rules for determining the
- 17 experience as a classroom teacher, librarian, counselor, or nurse
- 18 for a school district for which an individual is to be given credit
- 19 for years of service for purposes of a service record. Each
- 20 district shall maintain service records in accordance with
- 21 commissioner rules adopted under this subsection.

- 26 <u>teacher</u>, full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under
- 27 Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse not less than an annual

- 1 <u>salary of \$27,320.</u>
- 2 Sec. 21.4034. REDUCTIONS IN SALARIES OF CLASSROOM TEACHERS
- 3 AND OTHER DISTRICT EMPLOYEES. (a) This section applies only to a
- 4 widespread reduction in the amount of the annual salaries paid to
- 5 school district classroom teachers based primarily on district
- 6 financial conditions rather than on teacher performance.
- 7 (b) For any school year in which a school district has
- 8 reduced the amount of the annual salaries paid to district
- 9 classroom teachers from the amount paid for the preceding school
- 10 year, the district shall reduce the amount of the annual salary paid
- 11 to each district counselor, librarian, school nurse, and
- 12 school-level or district-level administrator by a percent or
- 13 fraction of a percent that is equal to the average percent or
- 14 fraction of a percent by which teacher salaries have been reduced.

- SECTION 9. Section 22.107(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:
- 25 (a) A school district shall pay each full-time district
- 26 employee, other than an administrator or a classroom teacher,
- 27 full-time librarian, full-time counselor certified under

- 1 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, or full-time school nurse [an employee
- 2 subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section 21.402], an
- 3 amount at least equal to \$500.
- 4 SECTION 10. Section 30.022(f), Education Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (f) Before the beginning of each fiscal year, the board
- 7 shall adopt a calendar for the school's operation that provides for

- SECTION 11. Section 30.052(f), Education Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (f) Before the beginning of each fiscal year, the board
- 16 shall adopt a calendar for the school's operation that provides for
- 17 at least[÷
- 18  $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$  the minimum number of days of instruction
- 19 required by Section 25.081[; and
- 20 [(2) the minimum number of days of service required by
- 21 Section 21.401].
- SECTION 12. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 25 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 26 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 27 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of

- 1 full-time district employees, other than administrators or
- 2 classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time counselors
- 3 certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, or full-time school
- 4 <u>nurses</u> [employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under
- 5 Section 21.402]; and
- 6 (2) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of 7 part-time district employees, other than administrators.
- 8 SECTION 13. Section 825.405, Government Code, is amended by
- 9 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (j) to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 (a) For members <u>in a personnel position that would have been</u>
- 12 entitled to the minimum salary for certain school personnel under
- 13 Section 21.402, Education Code, as that section existed on January
- 14 1, 2011, and for members who would have been entitled to the minimum
- 15 salary for certain school personnel under former Section 16.056,
- 16 Education Code, as that section existed on January 1, 1995, the
- 17 employing district shall pay the state's contribution on the
- 18 portion of the member's salary that exceeds the statutory minimum
- 19 salary, based on the member's years of experience.
- 20 (b) For purposes of this section, [÷
- [ $\frac{(1)}{(1)}$ ] the statutory minimum salary is the amount
- 22 <u>specified below</u> [for certain school personnel under Section 21.402,
- 23 Education Code, is the salary provided by that section] multiplied
- 24 by the cost of education adjustment applicable under Section

- 2 the same manner as the minimum salary for certain school personnel
- 3 under Section 21.402, Education Code, multiplied by the cost of
- 4 education adjustment applicable under Section 42.102, Education
- 5 Code, to the district in which the member is employed.
- 6 (j) At least once every four years, the Legislative Budget
- 7 Board shall review and make recommendations regarding revision of
- 8 the portion of the state's contribution for which school districts
- 9 are responsible under this section.
- SECTION 14. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 11 school year.
- 12 SECTION 15. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 13 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 14 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 15 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 16 effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of
- 17 the legislative session.
