A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to elementary class size limits in public schools.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 25.112, Education Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (d-1) and (e-1) to
6	read as follows:
7	(d) On application of a school district, the commissioner
8	shall [may] except the district from the limit in Subsection (a),
9	except as provided by Subsection (d-1) [if the commissioner finds
10	the limit works an undue hardship on the district]. An exception
11	expires at the end of the school year for which it is granted.
12	(d-1) The commissioner may not grant an exception to a
13	school district under Subsection (d) if the exception would:
14	(1) allow the district to enroll more than 25 students
15	in a class at a grade level subject to the limit in Subsection (a);
16	(2) result in the district exceeding a district-wide
17	average enrollment of 22 students in classes at grade levels
18	subject to the limit under Subsection (a); or
19	(3) negatively affect the education of students
20	enrolled in the district or at a district campus, as applicable, as
21	determined by the commissioner.
22	(e-1) The board of trustees of a school district may adopt a
23	policy authorizing the superintendent of the district to apply on
24	hehalf of the district as needed for an exception under

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 25.113(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (a) A campus or district that is granted an exception under
- 5 Section 25.112(d) from class size limits shall provide written
- 6 notice of the exception to the parent of or person standing in
- 7 parental relation to each student affected by the exception or
- 8 shall post notice of the exception on the district's Internet
- 9 website. The notice under this subsection must be in conspicuous
- 10 bold or underlined print or type and:
- 11 (1) specify the class for which an exception from the
- 12 limit imposed by Section 25.112(a) was granted;
- 13 (2) state the number of children in the class for which
- 14 the exception was granted; and
- 15 (3) unless posted on the district's Internet website,
- 16 be included in a regular mailing or other communication from the
- 17 campus or district, such as information sent home with students.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 19 school year.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 25 legislative session.
