## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the eligibility of a student to participate in extracurricular activities or competitions after transferring or 3 moving from one public school to another. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 33.088 to read as follows: Sec. 33.088. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN TRANSFER STUDENTS. (a) 8 9 Except as provided by Subsection (b), a student who transfers to a school or moves into the attendance zone of a school for the purpose 10 of participating in a specific extracurricular activity or a 11 12 specific University Interscholastic League competition offered at that school is not ineligible to participate in the activity or 13 14 competition if: 15 (1) the activity or competition is not offered at the 16 school from which the student transferred or moved; and (2) the student is otherwise eligible to participate 17 in the activity or competition. 18 (b) The University Interscholastic League may adopt rules 19 providing that a student who two or more times during a school year 20 21 transfers to a school or moves into the attendance zone of a school for the purpose of participating in a specific league competition 22 23 offered at that school is ineligible to participate in the 24 competition.

SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
school year.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect October 1, 2011.
