- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 533.01315, Government Code, is amended
- 7 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) Subject to Subsection (b-1), the [The] commission shall
- 10 ensure that a federally qualified health center, physician office,
- 11 urgent care facility, rural health clinic, or municipal health
- 12 department's public clinic is reimbursed for health care services
- 13 provided to a recipient outside of regular business hours,
- 14 including on a weekend or holiday, at a rate that is equal to the
- 15 allowable rate for those services as determined under Section
- 16 32.028, Human Resources Code, regardless of whether the recipient
- 17 has a referral from the recipient's primary care provider.
- 18 (b-1) A physician who is a specialist may not be reimbursed
- 19 under this section for the provision of specialty services.
- 20 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 21 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 22 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 23 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 24 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

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- 1 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 3 last day of the legislative session.
