- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the posting of the Ten Commandments in public school
- 3 classrooms.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 11.172 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11.172. POSTING OF TEN COMMANDMENTS. The board of
- 8 trustees of an independent school district may not prohibit the
- 9 posting of a copy of the Ten Commandments in a prominent location in
- 10 <u>a district classroom.</u>
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 12 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 18 legislative session.
