A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the entitlement of school districts and open-enrollment
- 3 charter schools to a certain funding level and to the appropriation
- 4 of money from the economic stabilization fund to be used for public
- 5 education.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Save Our Schools
- 8 Act.
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 42.2532 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 42.2532. ENTITLEMENT TO FUNDING LEVELS PROVIDED DURING
- 12 THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 13 this chapter, each school district and open-enrollment charter
- 14 school is entitled to receive at least the amount of state and local
- 15 maintenance and operations funding per student in weighted average
- 16 daily attendance that the district would be entitled to receive
- 17 under this chapter as it existed on January 1, 2011.
- 18 SECTION 3. In addition to amounts appropriated to the Texas
- 19 Education Agency for the Foundation School Program by S.B. 2, Acts
- 20 of the 82nd Legislature, 1st Called Session, 2011, or similar
- 21 legislation, the amount necessary to provide school districts and
- 22 open-enrollment charter schools with the full amount of funding to
- 23 which they are entitled under Section 42.2532, Education Code, as
- 24 added by this Act, for the state fiscal biennium beginning

- 1 September 1, 2011, as determined by the commissioner of education
- 2 in consultation with the Legislative Budget Board, is appropriated
- 3 from the economic stabilization fund to the Texas Education Agency
- 4 for the Foundation School Program under Chapter 42, Education Code.
- 5 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 6 over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, 1st Called Session, 2011,
- 7 regardless of the relative dates of enactment.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect only if it receives a vote
- 9 of two-thirds of the members present in each house of the
- 10 legislature, as provided by Section 49-g(m), Article III, Texas
- 11 Constitution.
- 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 17 legislative session.
