4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 531.09721 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 531.09721. COUNTY HIV AND AIDS SERVICES MEDICAID
7	WAIVER PROGRAM. (a) If feasible and cost-effective, the
8	commission may apply for a waiver from the federal Centers for
9	Medicare and Medicaid Services or another appropriate federal
10	agency to more efficiently leverage the use of state and local funds
11	in order to maximize the receipt of federal Medicaid matching funds
12	by providing counties in the state with the flexibility to provide
13	benefits under the Medicaid program to individuals who:
14	(1) have a net family income that is at or below 150
15	percent of the federal poverty level; and
16	(2) are eligible to receive medical treatment for HIV
17	or AIDS through the county.
18	(b) In establishing the waiver program required under this
19	section, the commission shall:
20	(1) ensure that the state is a prudent purchaser of the
21	health care services that are needed for the individuals described
22	by Subsection (a);
23	(2) solicit broad-based input from interested
24	persons;

No. 78 (3) ensure that the benefits received by an individual 1 2 through the county are not reduced once the individual is enrolled 3 in the waiver program; and 4 (4) employ the use of intergovernmental transfers and 5 other procedures to maximize the receipt of federal Medicaid 6 matching funds. 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the legislative session. 8
