6	amended by adding Section 1702.1301 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1702.1301. RESTRICTIONS ON APPEARANCE OF VEHICLES.
8	(a) This section applies only to a motor vehicle that displays the
9	<pre>name of a company and is used by:</pre>
10	(1) a guard company for the purpose of security patrol
11	services; or
12	(2) an alarm systems company while responding to an
13	alarm system or detection device.
14	(b) A motor vehicle described by Subsection (a):
15	(1) must display an inscription containing:
16	(A) the license holder's company name or the name
17	under which the company conducts business;
18	(B) the words "Private Patrol Services,"
19	"Security," "Alarm Response," "Security Patrol," or "Protection,"
20	in letters not less than two inches high; and
21	(C) the company's license number, in letters not
22	less than one inch high; and
23	(2) may not display a badge or shield emblem, the state
24	seal or another seal, or any variation on the state seal or another

- 1 seal that may give an impression that the person is connected with
- 2 the federal government, a state government, or a political
- 3 <u>subdivision of this state.</u>
- 4 (c) The inscription required by Subsection (b)(1)(B) must
- 5 be in a color sufficiently different from the body of the motor
- 6 vehicle that the lettering is plainly legible at a distance of not
- 7 less than 100 feet.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect October 1, 2011.
