R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Lake Travis High School boys' basketball coach Jan
2 Jernberg retired in May 2011, drawing to a close a distinguished
3 career in education that spanned three and a half decades; and

4 WHEREAS, Jan Jernberg graduated from Alamo Heights High
5 School in San Antonio in 1965 and went on to further his education
6 at St. Mary's University, North Texas State University, and Pan
7 American University; he began his teaching and coaching career in
8 Frisco in 1970 and has taught English, history, health, physical
9 education, and recreation in addition to serving as a coach; and

10 WHEREAS, Over the course of his 14-season tenure at Lake
11 Travis High, Coach Jernberg led the Cavaliers to unprecedented
12 success, reaching the regional round of the playoffs five times and
13 going all the way to the state tournament final four in 2010; his
14 efforts that year were honored with the 4A Coach of the Year award;

16 WHEREAS, Coach Jernberg's extensive list of accomplishments
17 also includes an overall record of 667 wins and 433 losses,
18 including a 302-135 mark at Lake Travis, and his teams made 21 trips
19 to the postseason; and

20 WHEREAS, In retirement, Coach Jernberg looks forward to
21 spending more time with his family, including his six
22 grandchildren, and he plans to stay active as a member of the board
23 of the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches; and

24 WHEREAS, Jan Jernberg's basketball expertise and his ability

1 to educate and inspire students have enabled him to make a positive
2 difference in the lives of hundreds of young people, and he may
3 indeed reflect with pride on his many achievements as a coach and
4 teacher; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
6 Legislature hereby congratulate Coach Jan Jernberg on his
7 retirement from Lake Travis High School and extend to him sincere
8 best wishes for continued happiness; and, be it further

9 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be

11 Texas House of Representatives.
