14 he helped to create a summer science program for elementary school

15 teachers at The University of Texas at Arlington; he also cofounded

16 the AWARE Foundation to encourage and reward Arlington teachers;

18 WHEREAS, Mr. Howell was a strong supporter of the UT

19 Arlington College of Nursing and served on the college's Dream

20 Makers scholarship committee; moreover, he personally funded

21 scholarships for deserving students attending a variety of

22 colleges; his advocacy earned him a Heroes for Children award from

23 the State Board of Education in 1994, and he was named Man of the

24 Year by both the Fort Worth Star-Telegram and the Arlington
