7 attended the Villa Sacred Heart academy in Pennsylvania before
8 graduating as salutatorian from East Douglas High School; she met
9 Dr. Charles Lee Liggett, Sr., while enrolled in nursing school at
10 Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia, and the two went on to
11 share a 67-year marriage and raise four children, Judy, Charles,

14 nearly three decades there, during which time they were active in
15 Trinity Episcopal Church; Mrs. Liggett and her husband eventually

22 generous ways, and she will always be remembered with admiration
