R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, State District Judge Rudy Delgado was selected as
2 the April 2011 Cancer Fighter of the Month by the American Cancer
3 Society of the Rio Grande Valley, and he is being recognized at the
4 annual Cattle Baron's Ball at La Antigua Revilla on June 25, 2011;

6 WHEREAS, Diagnosed with liver cancer in June 2008, just seven
7 months after losing a beloved son, Roman David Delgado, Judge
8 Delgado underwent chemotherapy and then had a liver transplant in
9 January 2010; he has faced his illness with courage and
10 determination, and he has allowed his experience to deepen his
11 faith, his compassion, and his appreciation for the blessings of
12 each day; and

13 WHEREAS, Judge Delgado was born in Mexico and raised in
14 Edinburg from infancy; after earning his bachelor's degree in
15 political science from the University of Michigan, he went on to
16 graduate from The University of Texas School of Law in 1981; he
17 moved back to the Rio Grande Valley in 1983 and served as assistant
18 district attorney before entering private practice and then
19 becoming judge of the Criminal Court of Law No. 1; in 2001, he was
20 elected judge of the 93rd District Court; and

21 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Judge Delgado enjoys the
22 support and encouragement of his wife, Diana Reyna Delgado, and
23 their sons, Rudy Dan, Ricco Diaman, and Ryan Diego; the grace he has
24 demonstrated in meeting his health challenges is an inspiration to

1 many people, and it is indeed fitting to honor him at this time;
2 now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
4 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby recognize Judge Rudy
5 Delgado on his selection as April 2011 Cancer Fighter of the Month
