1 WHEREAS, Former National Football League star Tim Brown has
2 been named a North Texas Father of the Year by the Sylvan Landau
3 Foundation; and

4 WHEREAS, The Father of the Year Awards program was
5 established in 1976 by Dallas men's clothier Sylvan Landau with the
6 mission of honoring exceptional fathers while raising funds for
7 children's charities; to date, the program has contributed nearly
8 \$4 million to more than 30 Metroplex charities; and

9 WHEREAS, Tim Brown graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School
10 in Dallas and went on to win the 1987 Heisman Trophy at the
11 University of Notre Dame; a first-round NFL draft pick, he played 16
12 seasons with the Oakland Raiders and retired in 2005; today he lives
13 in DeSoto with his wife and four children and oversees the Tim Brown
14 Foundation, which works to strengthen the moral character of
15 America's youth and to prevent childhood obesity; and

16 WHEREAS, Committed to the health and success of America's
17 children as well as his own, Tim Brown has set an inspiring example
18 of leadership, and he is truly deserving of this prestigious
19 accolade; now, therefore, be it
