R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The distinguished service of United States Marine
2 Corps officer Daniel Robnett of Plano is being deservedly
3 recognized with his promotion to the rank of captain and with his
4 receipt of the Navy Marine Corps Commendation Medal; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in Plano, Daniel Robnett graduated from Plano
6 Senior High School in 2000 and went on to enroll at the University
7 of North Texas; he enlisted in the Marine Corps Reserve and entered
8 boot camp in October 2001; while serving in Iraq as a member of the
9 reserve in 2004, he was wounded in action and was awarded the Combat
10 Action Ribbon; and

11 WHEREAS, On graduation from UNT, he concluded his reserve
12 service at the rank of sergeant and was commissioned as a second
13 lieutenant in the U.S. Marine Corps; later promoted to first
14 lieutenant, this valiant officer returned for a second tour of
15 combat duty in Iraq in 2009, and his meritorious service while
16 leading his platoon during that assignment earned him the Navy
17 Marine Corps Commendation Medal; and

18 WHEREAS, Captain Robnett now serves as the logistics officer
19 for the Third Battalion, First Marine Regiment, First Marine
20 Division, which is stationed at Camp Pendleton, California; he is
21 scheduled to begin his next overseas deployment in the fall of 2011;

23 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Daniel Robnett enjoys the love
24 and support of his wife, Stephanie, whom he met while at UNT; the

1 couple have three children, Corbin, Peyton, and Tatum; and

2 WHEREAS, Through his exceptional service as a member of the
3 U.S. Marine Corps, Captain Daniel Robnett has contributed to the
4 vital defense operations of our nation's military, and his courage,
5 dedication, and sacrifice are greatly appreciated by his fellow
6 Texans; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
8 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby congratulate Daniel
9 Robnett on his promotion to the rank of captain in the United States
10 Marine Corps and on his receipt of the Navy Marine Corps
