1 WHEREAS, The Methodist Richardson Foundation hosted the 8th
2 annual WildRide! WildRun! Against Cancer in Richardson on May 21,
3 2011; and

4 WHEREAS, Exceeding expectations, the event raised more than
5 \$170,000 for the Methodist Richardson Cancer Center and cancer
6 care; more than 1,800 cyclists and 650 runners participated in the
7 races, which were held in conjunction with the Richardson
8 WildFlower! Arts & Music Festival; and

9 WHEREAS, The WildRide! fund-raiser was created by Richardson
10 resident Richard White, a cycling aficionado, and to date has
11 raised more than \$1 million for the hospital and cancer center; the
12 2011 event drew sponsorship from numerous local businesses, and
13 many city leaders attended to welcome the huge crowd; and

14 WHEREAS, Established in 1994, the Methodist Richardson
15 Cancer Center opened its new Bush/Renner Campus location in 2008 to
16 bring an advanced level of cancer care to the region; the facility
17 offers a compassionate, multidisciplinary approach to care and
18 features such innovative treatment options as a noninvasive
19 radiation method featuring Novalis shaped beam technology; and

20 WHEREAS, The success of the WildRide! WildRun! Against Cancer
21 is a testament to the community's support for the Methodist
22 Richardson Cancer Center and its important contributions to cancer
23 care and treatment; now, therefore, be it
