1 WHEREAS, The Tejano music community lost one of its pillars
2 with the death of groundbreaking DJ Javier Villanueva of San Diego
3 on June 10, 2011, at the age of 61; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Alice on June 10, 1950, "J. V." Villanueva
5 was the son of Antonio and Ernestina Villanueva; he hosted a morning
6 show on KUKA 105.9-FM from the early days of Tejano radio and
7 introduced his fans to many artists who went on to become stars; in
8 addition, the popular broadcast personality served as a manager for
9 such artists as Laura Canales, Los Fabulosos Cuatro, and Carlos
10 Guzman; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Villanueva earned the nickname "the Dean of
12 Tejano" through his dedication to the music; he worked diligently
13 to promote gifted artists who fostered the development of the
14 genre, whether they were already established or just getting their
15 start, and he won official state recognition for Alice as the
16 birthplace of Tejano; in 1999, he helped found the Tejano Roots Hall
17 of Fame Museum, and he served as its chief executive officer; the
18 mayor of Alice proclaimed September 18 as Javier "J. V." Villanueva
19 Day in 2004, and the following year, *Tejano Magazine* named him
20 Tejano Music Person of the Year; and

21 WHEREAS, J. V. Villanueva brought Tejano music and joy into
22 the lives of innumerable people, and although he will be deeply
23 missed by his loved ones, his contributions will continue to
24 resonate in the years to come; now, therefore, be it
