WHEREAS, Mr. Stockwell has also been a rancher for more than 17 half a century, breeding Beefmaster cattle and working in close 18 partnership with the Agua Poquita Soil and Water Conservation 19 District; his membership in the Texas and Southwestern Cattle 20 21 Raisers Association dates back more than 50 years, and he has been recognized on many occasions for his conservation efforts; in 22 23 addition to his other accomplishments, he is a gifted singer who performed with several popular orchestras and at many weddings 24

1 during the 1940s and 1950s; moreover, he delighted audiences with 2 his wit as an emcee at local events; and

3 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Stockwell enjoys the 4 love and support of his wife of 65 years, Elma Carrillo Stockwell, 5 their sons, James and Mac, and their grandchildren, James, Jamie, 6 Julian Patrick, and Mack; and
