5 Ramirez began his career in law enforcement as a deputy with the
6 Starr County Sheriff's Office in 1987; he joined the Texas
7 Department of Criminal Justice as a prison guard in Beeville in
8 1994, and the following year, he went to work for the Rio Grande
9 City Police Department; and

10 WHEREAS, Among the first group of officers to patrol the
11 city's streets, this outstanding professional was promoted to
12 patrol sergeant in 1998; he was eventually named sergeant
13 detective, and his duties included serving as a supervisor in the
14 Criminal Investigation Department; he planned to retire in August
15 2011; and

16 WHEREAS, Robert Ramirez enjoyed the love and support of his
17 wife, Diana Gutierrez, and their four daughters, Veronica, Valerie,
18 Brenda, and Angelica; and

19 WHEREAS, A devoted family man and an exemplary public
20 servant, Sergeant Detective Robert Ramirez will long be remembered
21 by all those who were fortunate enough to know him; now, therefore,
