## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Ronald G. Girotto is retiring as president and chief 2 executive officer of the Methodist Hospital System in Houston on 3 December 31, 2011, concluding a noteworthy career with the 4 institution that has spanned more than three decades; and

5 WHEREAS, Since 1977, Ron Girotto has distinguished himself in a variety of executive positions within the Methodist system; he 6 7 was named president and CEO in September 2002, having served as acting president and CEO for the previous year; under his skilled 8 9 leadership, Methodist has partnered with Weill Cornell Medical College and New York Presbyterian Hospital, two of the country's 10 most prestigious medical organizations, and it has completed a \$1.5 11 12 billion expansion initiative; the system has opened new facilities, among them the Outpatient Center, the Methodist Hospital Research 13 14 Institute, and Methodist West Houston Hospital, and it has undertaken major growth projects in its community hospitals; 15 16 Methodist has been rated as one of America's Best Hospitals by U.S. News & World Report and for six consecutive years has been ranked 17 among the country's "100 Best Companies to Work For" by FORTUNE 18 magazine; and 19

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Girotto graduated from Pittsburg State 21 University in Kansas, where he majored in business administration 22 with concentrations in economics and finance; in addition, he holds 23 a master's degree in accounting from Kansas University and a 24 graduate degree in banking from Southern Methodist University, and

1 he has completed further studies at the University of Houston in federal income tax and at Harvard University in 2 financial 3 management and strategy in health care; he served as chair of the Greater Houston Hospital Council and has shared his expertise as a 4 member of the American College of Healthcare Executives, the Gulf 5 Coast Independent Organ Procurement Organization, and the Texas A&M 6 University Institute for Biosciences and Technology; and 7

8 WHEREAS, Very active in the wider community, Mr. Girotto serves on the Council of Overseers at the Jesse H. Jones Graduate 9 10 School of Management at Rice University and on the board of Faith in Practice; he has been a member of the boards of the Greater Houston 11 12 Partnership and the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation, and he has served as chair of the board of the Strake Jesuit College 13 14 Preparatory School and of the finance committee for the Blue Bird 15 Circle for Pediatric Neurology; moreover, he has worked in behalf of the American Heart Association as both chair and co-chair of the 16 17 annual Heart Walk in Houston; the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation presented him with its Living and Giving Award in 2003, 18 and he is the recipient of the Italian Flame award from the 19 Federation of Italian-American Organizations of Greater Houston, 20 the Celebrating Life award from the Living Bank, and the Pearl of 21 the Orient award from The People Caring for the Community, among 22 23 other accolades; and

24 WHEREAS, Ron Girotto has greatly benefited the Methodist 25 Hospital System through his vision, dedication, and commitment to 26 excellence in health care, and his retirement provides a fitting 27 opportunity to recognize his outstanding contributions to the
