## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The life of an admired Irving educator drew to a 2 close with the passing of Evelyn T. Clifton on April 28, 2011, at 3 the age of 82; and

WHEREAS, Born on January 20, 1929, in Bessemer, Pennsylvania, Evelyn Clifton knew from an early age that she wanted to teach; she graduated from Bessemer High School and Slippery Rock State Teachers College, and she later continued her education at North Texas State University, earning a master's degree in elementary school supervision in 1966; and

WHEREAS, After beginning her career in education in New Castle, Pennsylvania, in 1951, Mrs. Clifton embarked on her long association with the Irving Independent School District three years later, initially serving as a second grade teacher at Schulze Elementary School; she went on to teach first grade at Barton Elementary for a decade and then returned to Schulze as one of the district's first kindergarten teachers; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Clifton completed her tenure as a classroom 17 teacher at John Haley Elementary in 1975 and that same year began 18 her new role as an elementary consultant for the district; she 19 remained in that position until 1986, when she became the principal 20 21 Brandenburg Elementary and was instrumental in the at implementation of a bilingual program at the school; she retired in 22 23 1994, and her 37 years of dedicated service to Irving ISD were recognized when the Evelyn T. Clifton Early Childhood School was 24

1 named in her honor; in addition to meeting the demands of her 2 career, she was very active in the community and held memberships in 3 a variety of worthwhile organizations; and
