WHEREAS, Mr. Woody was dedicated to his community and possessed natural leadership ability; from 1964 to 1972, he served on the Carrollton City Council, and he was mayor pro tempore for two years; he was a member of the Metrocrest Hospital Authority board for more than two decades and served as chair, and he also sat on the boards of numerous banks; and
