

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Alfredo Delgado is retiring from the Housing
2 Authority of Del Rio on June 30, 2011, and the conclusion of his
3 outstanding 31-year tenure provides a fitting opportunity to
4 reflect on the contributions of this esteemed Texan; and

5 WHEREAS, A graduate of Sacred Heart Academy in Del Rio, Mr.
6 Delgado attended Texas A&I University, where he earned bachelor's
7 and master's degrees; he began his career as director of operations
8 of Planning and Urban Development in Corpus Christi and went on to
9 serve as director of planning of a health planning agency, a
10 position in which he supervised 12 counties and nearly \$46 million
11 in funding; he returned to his hometown in 1977 to join the Middle
12 Rio Grande Development Council and he was soon promoted to director
13 of manpower services; and

14 WHEREAS, In 1979, Mr. Delgado was hired by the Housing
15 Authority of Del Rio and under his able guidance as executive
16 director the number of units the agency oversaw has grown from 500
17 to more than 1,400 today; he has helped to increase services to
18 low-income residents by bringing the Modern Rehab Section 8 Housing
19 Program as well as the Rotary Villages I and II to Del Rio, and he
20 was instrumental in initiating the conversion of the Roswell Hotel
21 into a facility for elderly and disabled individuals; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Delgado has further contributed to his community
23 through his work as president of the San Felipe Lions Club, the Del
24 Rio Rotary Club, and the Del Rio Chamber of Commerce; and

1 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Delgado has enjoyed the
2 support of a loving family that includes his wife, Ana Maria, and
3 his children, Alfredo, Mark, John, and Anne; and

4 WHEREAS, Alfredo Delgado's dedication, professionalism, and
5 commitment to excellence have greatly benefited the citizens of Del
6 Rio, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a career well spent as
7 he embarks on the next exciting chapter of his life; now, therefore,
8 be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
10 Legislature, 1st Called Session, hereby congratulate Alfredo
11 Delgado on his retirement from the Housing Authority of Del Rio and
12 extend to him sincere best wishes for continued success in all of
13 his endeavors; and, be it further

15 prepared for Mr. Delgado as an expression of high regard by the
16 Texas House of Representatives.
