10 Krippner was the son of Kenneth and Pamela Krippner; he graduated  
11 from June Shelton High School and enlisted in the army; and

13 forces, Andrew Krippner inspired others with his leadership and  
14 service, and those who were fortunate enough to know him will always  
15 remember his wonderful sense of humor and will forever carry his
