1 WHEREAS, Evelyn Walters of Kingwood passed away on June 28,
2 2011, at the age of 70, leaving her circle of family and friends to
3 cherish their many happy memories of time spent in her company; and

4 WHEREAS, Born to Dovie and Watson Walters on January 23,
5 1941, in Ace, Evelyn Walters was the youngest of six children; she
6 grew up in Cleveland, Texas, and graduated from Cleveland High
7 School in 1959; she subsequently lived in Houston before settling
8 in Kingwood, where she raised her children and worked in new home
9 sales for Friendswood Development Company; and

10 WHEREAS, After some years away living in Santa Fe, New
11 Mexico, and Durango, Colorado, Ms. Walters returned to Kingwood and
12 became an active member of the community; she was there during
13 Tropical Storm Allison in 2001 and spent countless hours helping
14 her fellow residents recover; she also served as a caring volunteer
15 for Family Time Crisis and Counseling Center, in particular its
16 domestic violence shelter, The Door, and in 2002, she was
17 recognized with the organization's Women of Achievement award; in
18 addition, she belonged to the Kingwood Women's Club and worked to
19 raise funds for a variety of local charities; and

20 WHEREAS, Ms. Walters enjoyed fellowship and services at
21 Kingwood United Methodist Church and was a weekly participant in
22 the Society of St. Stephen ministry; above all else, she was devoted
23 to her loved ones, especially her six grandchildren, to whom she was
24 known as "MiMi"; and

1 WHEREAS, Evelyn Walters brightened the lives of all those who
2 were fortunate enough to know her, and she will always be remembered
3 with great admiration and affection; now, therefore, be it

6 Evelyn Walters and extend sincere sympathy to the members of her
