4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 49, Water Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 49.2127 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 49.2127. WATER MANAGEMENT PLANS FOR CERTAIN SPECIAL
8	WATER AUTHORITIES. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Authority" means a special water authority to
10	which this section applies under Subsection (b).
11	(2) "Firm water" means a supply of stored water that
12	could be supplied without shortage during each year of a simulated
13	repeat of the drought of record, while honoring all senior water
14	rights. During a drought of record, the supply of water for firm
15	water customers has a higher priority than that of interruptible
16	water customers.
17	(3) "Interruptible water" means a stored supply of
18	water for customers of an authority that must be curtailed before
19	the authority curtails firm water supplies.
20	(b) This section applies only to a special water authority
21	whose water management plan consists of a reservoir operation plan
22	for the operation of two water supply reservoirs and was:
23	(1) developed by an applicant for a permit under
24	Chapter 11; and

1	(2) originally required by a court order adjudicating
2	the water rights for those reservoirs.
3	(c) An authority's water management plan must:
4	(1) ensure that adequate firm water supplies are
5	available to meet the existing and projected demands of firm water
6	customers to the extent:
7	(A) provided by previously adjudicated water
8	rights; and
9	(B) other supplies are not available to the
10	authority to meet those firm water customer demands; and
11	(2) provide for curtailing water supplies under
12	interruptible commitments before requesting that firm water
13	customers institute voluntary drought contingency measures.
14	SECTION 2. A special water authority to which Section
15	49.2127, Water Code, as added by this Act, applies shall adopt or
16	amend its rules and its water management plan as required to
17	implement Section 49.2127, Water Code, as added by this Act.
