- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 552.3215, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 552.3215. DECLARATORY JUDGMENT, [OR] INJUNCTIVE
- 8 RELIEF, OR CIVIL PENALTY.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 552.3215, Government Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (b-1), (b-2), and
- 11 (1) to read as follows:
- 12 (b) An action for a declaratory judgment $_{\underline{\prime}}$ [or] injunctive
- 13 relief, or a civil penalty may be brought in accordance with this
- 14 section against a governmental body that violates this chapter.
- 15 (b-1) A governmental body that violates this chapter is
- 16 subject to a civil penalty not to exceed \$500 for each written
- 17 request for public information to which the governmental body's
- 18 violation applies. An action for a civil penalty in connection with
- 19 <u>a particular written request for public information may be brought</u>
- 20 <u>only if:</u>
- (1) the requestor notifies the governmental body in
- 22 writing that the requestor considers the governmental body to be in
- 23 violation of a specific provision of this chapter; and
- 24 (2) the governmental body has not remedied the

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- 1 violation or taken reasonable steps to remedy the violation before
- 2 the 10th day after the date on which the governmental body receives
- 3 the notification under Subdivision (1).
- 4 (b-2) A governmental body is subject to an additional civil
- 5 penalty not to exceed \$100 for each day the violation continues
- 6 after the last day under Subsection (b-1)(2) on which the
- 7 governmental body may avoid a civil penalty by remedying or taking
- 8 reasonable steps to remedy the violation.
- 9 (1) A civil penalty collected under this section shall be
- 10 deposited in the state treasury to the credit of the general revenue
- 11 fund.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 13 last day of the legislative session.
