CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, The United States is a nation of immigrants who have  
2 built the greatest democracy in the history of mankind; and

3           WHEREAS, The United States at many times during its history  
4 has allowed noncitizens to earn citizenship through honorable  
5 service in its armed forces; and

6           WHEREAS, Thousands of undocumented children have received a  
7 high school degree in Texas and are eager to serve in the United  
8 States armed forces, but are ineligible because they were brought  
9 to the United States illegally; and

10           WHEREAS, Approximately 40,000 noncitizens with visas or  
11 green cards are currently serving loyally in the United States  
12 armed forces; and

13           WHEREAS, Many noncitizens serving in the United States armed  
14 forces have given their lives in Iraq and Afghanistan during the  
15 last 10 years; now, therefore, be it

16           RESOLVED, That the 82nd Legislature of the State of Texas,  
17 1st Called Session, hereby respectfully urge the federal government  
18 to grant a conditional green card to noncitizens who (1) have  
19 received a high school diploma in the United States, and (2) arrived  
20 in this country before the age of 16, to allow them to enlist in the  
21 United States armed forces, if otherwise qualified; and, be it  
22 further

23           RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislature urge the federal  
24 government to award citizenship to these patriotic immigrants upon

1 the completion of four years of honorable service in the United  
2 States armed forces; and, be it further

3       RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official  
4 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to  
5 the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of  
6 Representatives of the United States Congress, to the secretary of  
7 defense, and to all the members of the Texas delegation to Congress  
8 with the request that this resolution be entered in the  
9 Congressional Record as a memorial to the Congress of the United  
10 States of America.
