Amend CSHB 2357 (house committee report) as follows:

  <u>feet</u> from the intersection <u>in accordance with the</u> [<del>or located</del>

  <u>according to</u>] standards established in the manual adopted by the

  Texas Transportation Commission under Section 544.001;
- $\underline{\ \ }$  (2) [au] be easily readable to any operator approaching the intersection;
  - (3) have affixed a flashing yellow circular beacon;
- $\underline{(4)}$  [, and] clearly indicate the presence of a photographic monitoring system that records violations that may result in the issuance of a notice of violation and the imposition of a monetary penalty; and
- (5) comply with design and size requirements established by the Texas Department of Transportation.

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 707.003(g), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (g) The local authority shall install signs along each roadway that leads to an intersection at which a photographic traffic signal enforcement system is in active use. <u>Each sign</u> [The signs] must:
- (1) be <u>located</u> at least 100 feet <u>but not more than 750</u>

  <u>feet</u> from the intersection <u>in accordance with the</u> [<del>or located</del>

  <u>according to</u>] standards established in the manual adopted by the

  Texas Transportation Commission under Section 544.001;
- $\underline{\ \ }$  (2) [au] be easily readable to any operator approaching the intersection;
  - (3) have affixed a flashing yellow circular beacon;
- (4) [, and] clearly indicate the presence of a photographic traffic signal enforcement [photographic monitoring] system that records violations that may result in the issuance of a notice of violation and the imposition of a monetary penalty; and
  - (5) comply with design and size requirements

established by the Texas Department of Transportation.
