Amend CSHB 2784 (senate committee printing) in SECTION 1 of the bill, by striking amended Section 132.061(f), Education Code (page 2, lines 57 through 67), and substituting the following:

(f) A career school or college shall record a grade of "incomplete" for a student who withdraws <u>during the portion of a</u> <u>course or program for which the student is not eligible to collect a</u> <u>refund under Subsection (b)(4)</u> [but is not entitled to a refund <u>under Subsection (b)(4)(F)</u>] if the student requests the grade at the time the student withdraws and the student withdraws for an appropriate reason unrelated to the student's academic status. A student who receives a grade of incomplete may re-enroll in the <u>course or</u> program during the 12-month period following the date the student withdraws and complete those incomplete subjects without payment of additional tuition <u>for that portion of the course or</u> <u>program</u>.
