Amend SB 1114 (house committee printing) as follows:

(1) In SECTION 3 of the bill, in amended Section 1001.055(a), Education Code (page 2, lines 2-3), between "<u>enable</u> <u>the school</u>" and "<u>to print</u>", insert "<u>and each approved parent-taught</u> <u>course provider (approved by the Texas Department of Public Safety</u> <u>under Section 521.205 of the Transportation Code</u>)".

(2) In SECTION 3 of the bill, in added Section 1001.055(a-1), Education Code (page 2, line 9), between "<u>school</u>" and "<u>must</u>", insert "<u>or Department of Public Safety approved course</u> <u>provider</u>".

(3) In SECTION 3 of the bill, in added Section 1001.055(a-1)(2), Education Code (page 2, line 13), between "<u>driver</u> <u>education school</u>" and the underlined period, insert "<u>or Department</u> <u>of Public Safety approved course provider</u>".

(4) In SECTION 3 of the bill, in added Section 1001.055(a-2), Education Code (page 2, line 14), between "<u>driver</u> <u>education school</u>" and "<u>that purchases</u>", insert "<u>or Department of</u> <u>Public Safety approved course provider</u>".

(5) In SECTION 3 of the bill, in added Section 1001.055(a-2), Education Code (page 2, line 19), between "<u>school</u>" and "<u>shall electronically</u>", insert "<u>or Department of Public Safety</u> <u>approved course provider</u>".

(6) In SECTION 4 of the bill, in added Section 1001.2511(b), Education Code (page 3, lines 15-17), strike "<u>and who has not</u> <u>previously submitted fingerprints to the Department of Public</u> <u>Safety or been subject to a national criminal history record</u> information review".

(7) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION ____. Section 1001.253, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

(d) Except as provided by <u>Subsection (g) or</u> Section 1001.254, a driver education instructor license authorizing a person to teach or provide classroom training may not be issued unless the person:

(1) has completed nine semester hours of driver and

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traffic safety education or a program of study in driver education approved by the commissioner from an approved driver education school; and

(2) holds a teaching certificate and any additional certification required to teach driver education.

(g) A driver education instructor license authorizing a person to teach or provide classroom training may be issued to a person who satisfies the requirements of Subsection (d)(1) but does not satisfy the requirements of Subsection (d)(2), except that such a license may authorize the license holder to teach or provide classroom training only for a driver education school that is located in a county that has a population of at least 275,000 but not more than 285,000 and is operated by a private primary or secondary school or open-enrollment charter school. This section does not affect any law or school policy that requires a review of criminal history record information.
